- **☒ Make recommendations to the MNW Board of Directors**

What Recommendations Does the SIAC Make?

- a. **Major educational needs**
- b. **Student learning goals**
- c. **Long-range goals that include state indicators addressing reading, mathematics and science achievement**
- d. **Annual improvement goals**
- e. **Progress achieved with the annual improvement goals**
- f. **Progress achieved with other locally determined core indicators**
- g. **Harassment or bullying prevention goals, programs, training, and other initiatives**
