



Mastering New Worlds

**Manson Northwest Webster Community School
Board of Education Meeting
August 3, 2010**

The Manson Northwest Webster Community School Board held a public hearing on Tuesday, August 3, 2010, in the superintendent's office at the Administration Center.

Pres. Paterson called the meeting to order at 7:05 a.m.

Present: Paterson, Swartzendruber, DeWall, Paterson, Jacobsen. Absent: Lawler, Hewitt, Johnson. Others present: Supt. Egli, Erin Schroeder.

Motion by DeWall, second by Swartzendruber, to approve the agenda. All ayes, motion carried.

Mr. Paterson welcomed the group and led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Mr. Paterson opened the public hearing.

Jim Hosek of Allers and Associates presented plans and specifications on the new bus barn that is to be constructed. It will be a 54x186 building. There will be a two-stall heated wash bay with cement floor, seven stalls for bus parking with gravel flooring. There will also be parking on the north side for four vans, and a fifty foot concrete apron on the west side of the building. Utilities will be connected to the fitness center. There are four bid packages; excavating, concrete work, mechanical work, and electrical work.

Mr. Egli stated the projected cost of the bus barn is \$425,000. If the District receives the USDA grant, it will pay for 35% of the total cost. A loan will be obtained from Heartland Bank for \$400,000, with annual payments of \$90,000. The USDA grant would reduce that loan amount.

Mr. Paterson closed the public hearing.

Motion by Jacobsen, second by DeWall to adjourn. All ayes, motion carried.
